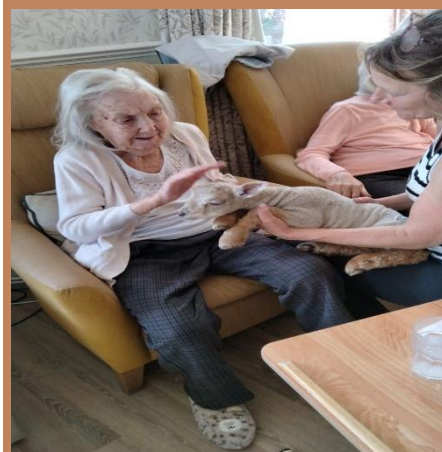
Local Schools and Care Homes

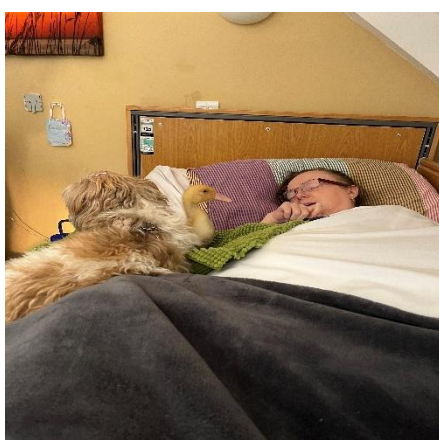

St George's Day was commemorated with arts and crafts, a quiz and singalong. Thanks again to Sarah- Jane who has now offered to volunteer at Crossways.

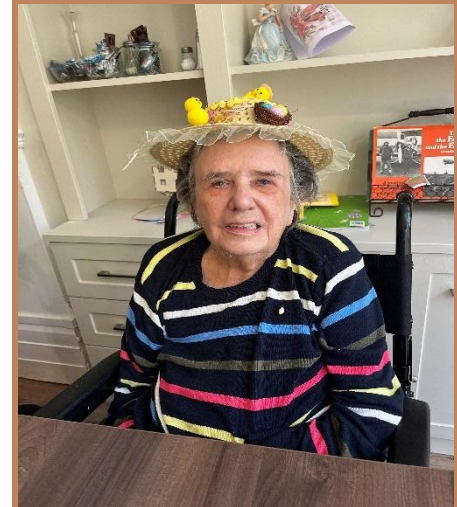
We also enjoy our weekly Zoom sing along with 'Forget me know Chorus' and are joined by lots of other care homes across the country where we enjoy a singing together.
